#### Important Notice:


Please be advised that per statewide policy, our lab is required to shut down annually, mid-June, to conduct mandatory fiscal year-end inventory. Production of eyeglasses will cease. Orders received on or after shutdown will not be entered or processed and will be held until conclusion of inventory. Inventory generally lasts two weeks. Facilities will notice a delay in the delivery of completed orders and experience a couple weeks without receipt of shipments from our lab. We apologize for the unfortunate inconvenience this causes and truly appreciate your patience.

## Our Story

The Dixon Optical Lab has been producing quality eyewear for over thirty years through the Illinois Correctional Industries (ICI) optical reentry program. ICI offers incarcerated offenders the opportunity to develop usable skills and positive work habits; all while giving back to the community. Our optical program allows the State of Illinois to provide cost-effective, quality prescription eyewear to residents throughout the state. Dixon's goal is to achieve a constant high standard of quality while maintaining economical operations. Our lab strives to provide our customers with products and services that conform to their specifications and requirements.

Moreover, offender staff are highly encouraged to take the American Board of Opticianry (ABO) certification exam offered through our lab, for the purpose of becoming ABO Board-Certified opticians. As of January 2019, well over half of our offender workforce will have become ABO certified.



### Account Information Updates

Facilities are responsible for keeping their account information with our lab current. Changes or updates must be brought to our lab's attention as soon as possible. This includes any changes in staffing as it affects the ordering of eyeglasses. ### State of Illinois Facility Optical Order Form

A *State of Illinois Facility Optical Prescription Order Form* is provided for the purpose of placing optical orders for residents housed in facilities ran and operated by the State of Illinois. This form has been emailed to each facility as a fillable PDF. **Forms completed by hand will not be accepted.** Facility staff must ensure the form they are using is the most current version. To verify this, refer to the bottom left-hand corner of the form where it should state that the form has been updated 1/2019. No other version of this form will be accepted. Optical orders are to be submitted by email, as a PDF scan, to our lab email.

### Status Requests

Any facility requesting the status of an optical order being fabricated by our lab must do so by sending an email directly to our lab at [doc.dixilab@illinois.gov](mailto:doc.dixilab@illinois.gov). If requesting the status of multiple orders, each resident's name and identification number (if applicable) must be listed in the body of the message. There is no longer an actual paper or electronic form to fill out for these requests. No status will be provided over the phone at any time. Additionally, facilities should refrain from sending copies of orders they seek the status of, as this may result in duplicate eyeglasses being fabricated.

### Stock Frame Order Form

A *State of Illinois Facility Stock Frame Order Form* is provided for the purpose of ordering replacement frame samples that are no longer covered under warranty, to order additional sizes and colors of frame samples for more variety, or simply to purchase extra frames to have on hand. Frames cost \$15 each unless marked with an asterisk, as these frames cost \$35. Stock frame orders are to be submitted directly to our lab by email. No orders will be accepted by fax or mail. A stock frame order form is not intended for use when ordering a frame for a specific patient.


## Warranty Information

**Frame Warranty:** Dixon Correctional Industries Optical Lab warrants all frames supplied by our lab to be free of manufacturing defects in materials or workmanship for a period of 180 days (approximately six months) from the original ship date from our lab, to the ordering facility. Shipping charges to return warranty eligible frames will be covered by ICI, and a prepaid shipping label will be issued for the return of the broken/defective frame(s). Facility staff must return the broken/defective frame(s), the existing lenses, and a copy of the original paperwork sent with the order. Frame defects must be brought to our lab's attention within five (5) business days from the date of signed receipt by facility staff or until dispensed to the patient, whichever comes first.

**Lens Warranty:** Dixon Correctional Industries Optical Lab warrants all lenses fabricated by our lab to be free of manufacturing defects and to have been fabricated within ANSI standards, according to the optical order submitted. Lenses are covered under warranty for a period of five (5) business days from the date of signed receipt by facility staff or until dispensed to the patient, whichever comes first. In the event of a lab error in the fabrication of lenses, return shipping charges will be covered by ICI, and a prepaid shipping label will be issued. Facility staff must return the lenses and a copy of the original paperwork sent with the order. Facility errors will be remade at the facility, resident, or Wexford's expense. Dixon Correctional Industries will not pay return shipping charges for facility errors.

To request a return label, facility staff must submit a request by email containing the following information in the body of the message:

- Resident first and last name
- Resident identification number (if applicable)
- Job ID# - this will be indicated on the paperwork that came with the order
- Brief reasoning for request of a return label
